

- Governor’s Seal:** Awarded to students who complete an Advanced Studies Diploma with an average grade of B or better, and successfully complete college-level coursework that will earn the student at least nine transferable college credits in AP or dual enrollment.
  - Average of B (use overall weighted GPA)
  - 9 transferrable AP or DE classes (use attempted credits not actual test scores)
  
- Board of Education Seal:** The Board of Education Seal is awarded to students who complete the requirements for a Standard Diploma or Advanced Students Diploma with an average grade of “A”. When calculating this use all classes, weighted.
  - Average of A (use overall weighted GPA)
  
- Board of Education Career and Tech Education Seal:**
  - Earn a Standard or Advanced Diploma and complete a prescribed sequence of courses in a career and technical education concentration or specialization and maintain a B or better average in those courses.
  - OR Pass an exam or an occupational competency assessment in a career and technical education concentration or specialization that confers certification or occupational competency credential from a recognized industry, trade or professional association. W!SE doesn’t count since it is a graduation requirement.
  - OR Acquire a professional license in that career and technical education field from the Commonwealth of Virginia.
  
- Board of Education Diploma Seal for Science, Technology, Engineering and Mathematics (STEM) (Currently only Nurse Aid students are eligible)**
  - Earn a Standard or Advanced Diploma and satisfy all math and science requirements for the Advanced diploma with a B or better in all course work
  - AND successfully complete 25 hours or more work-based learning opportunity in STEM area
  - AND satisfy all requirements for a CTE coherent sequence and pass a CTE credential or exam approved by the Board that confers a college-level credit in a STEM field.
  
- Board of Education Excellence in Civics Education** Awarded to students who have good attendance and no disciplinary infractions. Students must pass VA and US History and Government with a grade of B or higher. Student must also meet one of the following criteria.
  - Complete 50 hours of voluntary participation in community service or extracurricular activities
  - ROTC levels 1-4
  - Eagle Scout, Gold Award or participation in Boys Scouts or Girls Scouts
  - Boys State, Girls State
  - Military Enlistment prior to graduation
  
- Board of Education Seal of Biliteracy**
  - Passed the AP Language Exam with a 3 or higher
  
- Science and Environment Seal (Currently only CBGS students are eligible IF they also earned the community service cord offered by CBGS)**
  - Entered 9<sup>th</sup> grade in 2018-2019 or later and earned a Standard or Advanced Diploma
  - Complete three different laboratory science courses and at least one rigorous advanced level or postsecondary level laboratory science course, each with a B
  - Complete at least 50 hours of voluntary participation in community service or extracurricular activities that involve the application of science such as environmental monitoring, protection, management or restoration.
  - Complete laboratory or field science research and present that research in a formal, juried setting
